



For this game, all players will need a piece of paper and a pencil. The object of the game is to be the first player to finish drawing their picture.

For your picture to be finished you need:

- a square for the body of a house
- a triangle for the roof
- two more squares for windows
- a rectangle for a front door
- a diamond for a door knob
- a circle for the sun in the sky
- three hexagons for paving stones leading up to the front door

# SHAPE RACE

## Instructions:

1. Every player chooses a starting point on the game board and places a counter on their chosen spot. You can all start in a different place if you like.
2. Take it in turns to roll the die and move around the board in a clockwise direction.
3. Whatever shape you land on, you use to draw your picture.
4. For your picture to be finished you would need to land on 3 different squares, 1 triangle, 1 rectangle, 1 diamond, 1 circle and 3 different hexagons.
5. Keep adding to your drawing with each shape, but if you land on a shape you no longer need, you miss that turn.
6. Keep moving around the board until someone completes their drawing.

This activity reinforces knowledge of 2D shapes and simple counting and allows children to experience the randomness of chance. Board games also teach the important skills of fair play and acceptance.
